

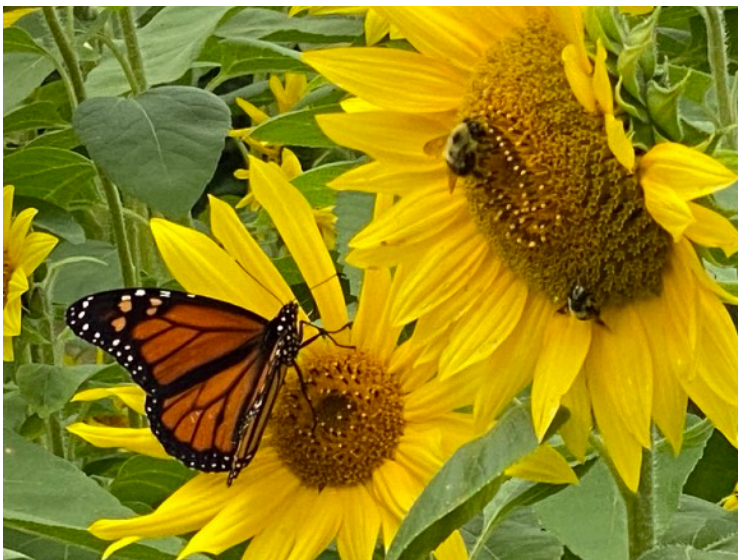

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Town of Londonderry Special Town Meeting

Took place on Wednesday, July 22nd, 2026, at 6 pm at the Town Hall in South Londonderry.

General Office Manager Position (Article 13):

Voters reconsidered the May 11, 2026 vote regarding Article 13, which proposed raising up to \$81,000 for a shared General Office Manager salary and benefits. Following discussion, a paper-ballot vote of 71-63 passed the motion to postpone the article indefinitely, thereby officially rejecting the position.

Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Tax Rate: Following the special town meeting, a separate session set the municipal tax rate. Utilizing town surpluses, \$150,000 was allocated to lower the municipal rate to 70.28 cents on a \$3.6 million budget. The resulting homestead tax rate was set at \$2.3973, and the nonhomestead rate at \$2.7279 per \$100 of assessed value

NOTICE OF ORDINANCE ADOPTION

The Town of Londonderry Selectboard hereby gives notice pursuant to 24 V.S.A. 1972(a)(1) that on August 03, 2026, the Board voted to adopt an Ordinance Controlling the Use of Alcoholic Beverages on Town Property.

In summary, the Ordinance Controlling the Use of Alcoholic Beverages on Town Property regulates the use of alcohol on Town Property by prohibiting its use unless specifically permitted by the Selectboard. This Ordinance supersedes the prior Alcoholic Beverage Control Ordinance.

The complete text of the Ordinance Controlling the Use of Alcoholic Beverages on Town Property can be examined on the Town's web site (www.londonderryvt.gov) or at the Londonderry Town Clerk's office, 100 Old School Street, South Londonderry, VT 05155. Questions or comments regarding this proposed ordinance can be directed to Town Administrator Aileen Tulloch by phone at 802-824-3356, by email at townadmin@londonderryvt.gov, or by US Mail at 100 Old School Street, South Londonderry, VT 05155.

Unless a petition is filed as described below, the Ordinance shall become effective 60 days after the date of its adoption. Notice is hereby given of the right to petition for a permissive referendum vote on this ordinance at an annual or special meeting as provided for in 24 V.S.A 1973. Such petition for a permissive referendum must be signed by not less than five (5) percent of the qualified voters of the Town of Londonderry and shall be presented to the Selectboard or the Town Clerk within forty-four (44) days following the date of adoption.

Neighborhood Connections Plans Events for Caregivers

Those with Dementia Neighborhood Connections is excited to serve members of our community who are caregivers working with loved ones experiencing memory challenges or a diagnosis of dementia or related disorders. Our initial programming is a group format for caregiver support and for participant engagement, modelled after existing successful programs. The group, called "Remembering Together," will meet every other week on Thursdays for two hours between 11:00 am and 1:00 pm. Scheduled meetings are July 16, July 30, August 3, and August 27th. During this time, special activities, including music, will be held with those experiencing cognitive changes, while caregivers will meet in an adjoining room to share experiences and challenges, drawing support and ideas from each other. You may participate in one, several, or all four sessions.

Both groups will be guided by experienced staff. It will be led by Neighborhood Connections staff member Lois Schram Osnow, a licensed clinical social worker with an extensive background in gerontology. Prior to moving to Vermont, she was co-founder and owner of LS Gerontology Seminars, founded in 2002, where she instituted culture change projects in more than 25 long-term care facilities in the tri-state area.

The sessions will be held at our meeting facilities in the Mountain Marketplace, on the corner of Routes 11 and 100 in Londonderry. A light lunch will be included. There is no charge for lunch or the event. Please reserve a seat ahead of time by calling Lois at (802) 824-4343 or to request more information.
