



## February - Black History Month

This is Garret Morgan, the inventor of the 3-light traffic light and the safety hood protection device, among other things. In order to sell the safety hoods, he would hire a white actor to take credit as the inventor.


In the middle of the night in 1916, there was a massive tunnel explosion in Cleveland- the rescue teams were actually dying from chemical and smoke inhalation- so Garret and his brother showed up with 4 safety hoods. Everyone was looking at them all crazy until they went into the tunnel, wearing pajamas and the hoods, and started carrying out victims. He went in 4 times, bringing people out on his back. When fire departments discovered the success of his invention, the orders started rolling in. Until the newspaper showed him during the rescue, and that he was black. Most southern orders were cancelled. He never got recognition for saving people that day, either.

He only had an elementary school education. Morgan was inventing life-saving things with an elementary school education! Things we STILL use in 2026.

### Garrett Morgan

1877 - 1963

With only an elementary school education, Garrett began his career as a sewing machine mechanic. He soon blazed a trail for African American inventors with patents, including those for an improved sewing machine, three-light traffic signal, hair straightener, and a safety hood which served as a precursor to the gas masks used in World War I.

**Bone Builders** - The RSVP Bone Builders Osteoporosis Prevention and Reversal Program is an effective combination of weight bearing, balance and stretching exercises. Bone Builders is a free, ongoing program with a choice of morning or afternoon classes. Group classes include standing and sitting exercises using light hand weights.

**Walk with Ease** - Walk with Ease is an evidence-based Wellness Program developed by the Arthritis Foundation. It uses the simple activity of walking to improve health and well-being, and is good for nearly everyone, from absolute beginners to people who have been active for years. This is a year-round program, with walks outdoors in pleasant weather, and indoors in the winter courtesy of our partnership with the Chris Lewit Tennis Academy.

VT-ALERT is used by the state and local responders to notify the public of emergency situations. **Those include, but are not limited to, evacuation information; chemical spills; shelter-in-place alerts; severe weather advisories; boil water advisories; and roadway interruptions.** Residents can tailor the alerts to specific locations, types of alerts, and on which devices they will be notified.






