Markers for unmarked graves discussed. No decision made.

Maureen has reached out to Jonathan Stevens to see if he might know of where or how we might learn who is buried in Middletown (in the unmarked graves).

Discussion about the 'M' and 'S' plots. (Middletown) Maureen to reach out to family member of 'M' plot to see if they would be willing to sell the plots back to the town.

Luke G. to work on wall in Middletown (after providing estimate) in July.

Replacement of slate headstones discussed. Andie to put out a question to VOCA, Maureen to work on this.

Graves without headstones? Maureen to bring her list to out next meeting.

New business: Correspondence was shared from the town in regard to a Cemetery Commission issue.
