- 4. Minutes approval.
 - a. Jason moved, Rick seconded, motion carried
- 5. Volunteer Agreement
 - a. Formal volunteer agreement from VLTC includes scope of work, i.e. coach vs. chaperone. Conversation sparked by 3/4 Girls gym campout event. Due to Landgrove not being insured by VLTC, we can not have a Landgrove chaperone at this one event. Flood Brook is additionally insured for this event. Agreement will be submitted to town attorney for approval
- 6. Checkr
 - a. previously used free Vermont criminal check and National sex offender check. Chekr is \$30/background check. VLTC recommended using Chekr as it utilizes Soc. Sec. tracing and completes a national criminal check. Each check is good for one year.
- 7. Board Position Terms
 - a. Upon review of the MTRD multi-town agreement, member terms were in need of discussion. Broad conversation about terms and positions was had. Liam will work up a matrix to show expiration dates for positions and this will be an agenda item for the next meeting to begin conversations on the new contract for 7/1/26.
- 8. MTRD JD updates (hiring)

a. At the recent selectboard meeting the MTRD job description was slightly altered and approved by selectboard to allow the MTRD to hire individuals - i.e. referees. Stack Sports/Stack Officials simplifies this hiring process as well.

9. WRSA & FBAA 1-year check-ins

a. Request to be more active, updating the FB page. Additional funding and grant opportunities to be sought after this year? Grafton Cheese looking into sponsoring our softball/baseball jerseys. Jason questioned how much has Liam been able to start networking for additional sporting and activity opportunities in the communities.

10. Town Report

a. Town report has been sent to town clerks. MTRDAC members who are town reps can help by informing people of the efforts to grow community programs through MTR.

11. New Website

a. Will noted having difficulty finding link to Stack Sports. Add Peru Makery. Down the road - summer sports camps - will start with camps that exist.

12. Paying Refs

a. FBAA no longer carries insurance to run programs and therefore pay offcials. WR pays M. Bailey with W-9/1099 every year. Could WR consider paying Pat (basketball) as he has requested to be paid as a contracted employee and that cannot happen through the town. General consensus is not at this time.

a. The Advisory Committee, after completing Liam's 1.5 year review, advises to increase his salary the budgeted FY25 cost of living increase of \$2000 to \$57,000, retroactive to January 1st, 2025.
